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COVID-19 SAFETY AT KANDALORE

Camp Kandalore will adopt a multi-layered approach to protect the health and wellbeing of our community during the COVID-19 Pandemic. We will provide all registered families with our COVID-19 guidelines for their program prior to their session start date. At this time, we would like families to be aware that the following measures will be adopted this summer. They include, masks and PPE, frequent handwashing/sanitization, physical distancing, reduced capacity, screening and testing, cohorting, enhanced cleaning and disinfecting, outdoor programming and outdoor dining.





PJ CAMPER PROGRAM (BORN 2010 - 2015)

The August PJ Session is a 1-week program that will give PJ campers a chance to try as many activities in-camp as possible. Like our regular one-week program, we pre-program your camper's activities, and PJs will travel with their cabin group with a leader in training (LIT) or staff member to each activity. PJs will get to experience a canoe trip by staying overnight on the island across the lake from Kandalore or a one-night trip to the Leslie Frost Centre, a conservation area surrounding Kandalore.

NEW PJ PROGRAM DATES

AVAILABILITY

This program can accommodate 120 PJ campers.

COST: \$1,620.00 (not including HST) + testing fee





INTER CAMPER PROGRAM (BORN 2008-2009)

The Inter Session is a 4-week program that combines an in-camp activity experience and a 4-day whitewater canoe trip down either the Madawaska, Mattawa or French rivers, all great to learn on. Inters will do six activities a day including a swimming class where they will work towards achieving their red-cross levels and a canoeing class where they will work through ORCKA flat water canoeing levels.

Inters will also have the opportunity to participate in special programs designed to challenge and build their skills, be active, and interact with others. Some of the special programs include Ghost Island cookouts, outdoor rock climbing and repelling and Regatta events.

SENIOR CAMPER PROGRAM (BORN 2005-2007)

Like our usual 4-week Senior Session, this experience combines an in-camp activity program, and the option of a 5-day, 7-day, or 12-day whitewater canoe trip. Seniors will engage in activities of their choice as well as instructional activities such as achieving their Bronze Medallion and/or Cross swim certification and ORCKA Flatwater level 4 certification.

Seniors will also have the opportunity to participate in special programs designed to challenge their skills, be active and interactive with others and allow for them to reflect on their camp experience. In addition to the in-camp activities, Senior's will also have the opportunity to participate in senior specific experiences that we offer each year like the one-day Looper and Group Watch.

LEADER IN TRAINING (LIT) PROGRAM (born in 2004-2005)

NEW PROGRAM:

Our revised LIT program will welcome leaders born in 2004 and 2005. During their first two weeks, LITs will gain experience in the following areas:

- Leadership sessions
- Course credit material
- ORCKA Flatwater 4
- 5 day canoe trip on the Madawaska
- Bronze Med/Cross and Emergency First Aid
- 2 Activity Placements

For the remainder of their program, LITs will further their leadership development by supporting camp in the following ways:

- Cabin placements with Senior and PJ Campers
- 4 Activity Placements
- Organisation of an Evening Program, an All-Camp game & themed meals
- Completing their Bronze Med/Cross

LIT HYBRID and EXPLORER 2 PROGRAM (LEADERS BORN IN 2004)

NEW PROGRAM

The program on our LIT Hybrid and Explorer 2 trips will remain the same, however, we will be adjusting the in-camp program in order to safely cohort trip groups before they leave. LIT Hybrids and Explorer 2s will spend the first 7 days of their session in-camp. During this time they will participate in the following certifications, activities and sessions:

- Flatwater progression and paddling practice
- Team building sessions
- Risk management sessions
- Self-care discussion
- Packing out food and gear for trip
- Mapping session and trip route overview
- Tripper & Explorer expectations
- Bronze Medallion and/or Bronze Cross Certification
- ORCKA Flatwater Level 4 Certification

Once the LIT Hybrids and Explorer 2s have returned to camp, they will spend a week placed with a Senior cabin and a week placed with a PJ camper cabin. During this time they will also have the ability to gain experience shadowing counsellors at two activity placements.
