### Tuck

- Candy tuck every few days (included in fees)
- Tuck shop is open twice a day for clothing
- Money for tuck must be pre-deposited in the [Kandalore Registration Portal](#)
- [Online Tuck Shop](#) available for orders year round

### Communication

- Section Heads' camper update by end of first week (you may choose to opt out of these updates)
- New camper updates by end of 3<sup>rd</sup> full day

### Regatta

- First year campers receive a free regatta t-shirt
- Regatta team placements will be randomly assigned, unless campers have an existing family regatta team.
- We do not accept regatta team requests
- Regatta teams are announced on arrival

### Devices

- No electronic devices permitted (phones, iPads, speakers, e-readers, gaming devices, styling tools, laptops, smart watches etc.). Items will be confiscated

### Transportation Options

- Bus \$95 + HST
- Airport \$130 + HST

Transport can be refunded up to 2 weeks before session start date

### International Campers

- Items provided by camp: paddle, life jacket, pillow, sleeping bag, bed sheet
- Bus / Airport fees are included with registration
- Confirm your camper UM Status with EduCanada
- Store phone, passport, money with office team
- International campers' letters can be scanned and sent to families by email, every few days

### Health Centre

- Bring medication to camp in original packaging
- All medication, vitamins, daily supplements, etc must be handed in to the Nurses at drop off
- All medication collected from Nurses at pick up
- Bring 2 Epi-Pens to camp; 1 for inside cabin and 1 is kept with camper at all times
- [Closest hospital to Kandalore](#) (Haliburton)

### Lost and Found

- Labelled items will be brought to Toronto office at the end of the summer for collection/mailling
- Unlabelled items will be donated at the end of the summer, and are not brought to Toronto
- We strongly encourage labelling all clothing and belongings, and do not bring valuables to camp

### Trip

- Trip emails (departure and return to camp) will be sent to all families
- Halfway trip updates are provided for Explorer and X2
- Wet clothes are for paddling, dry clothes are for the campsite and overnight
- Whitewater paddle and helmet are provided by camp

### Mail and Bunk1 (Email and Photo Gallery)

- [Bunk1 Instructions](#) to send letters to your campers (please note that campers cannot reply using email / Bunk1)
- We make sure all families will see at least 1 camper, 1 trip group and 1 cabin photo
- Photos are uploaded to Bunk1 every few days
- We recommend sending pre-stamped and addressed envelopes with your camper, so they can send you letters from camp!
- We ask that you limit to 1 care package per camper
